1. Language

3. Accessibility

- Advanced subtitling
 With the option of including annotations to expand or clarify information
- Paragraph highlighting during reading
 To guide the user's attention to the part of the text being narrated at any given moment
- Multimodal content generation
 Simultaneous creation of material in multiple formats (written text, audios, illustrated versions, or combinations thereof) from a single initial input, facilitating the adaptation of material to different learning styles and needs.
